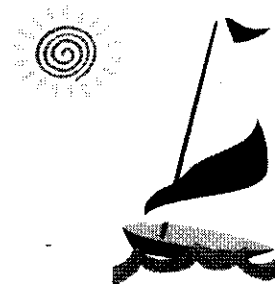
# Smooth Sailing!

Bring supplies to every class every day. It is the student's responsibility to replenish supplies when they are low.

### Suggested Supply List for 6<sup>th</sup> grade

- One **red folder** with 2 pockets
- Bookbag** which must fit in locker (i.e. none with wheels)
- Ruler** w/standard and metric measurements
- Large** zippered **pencil case** (one with 3 holes that can be carried easily in binders but can be taken out when needed for other classes)
  - Rolls of **scotch tape**/small tape dispenser
  - Colored pencils** or **THIN magic markers**
  - #2 Pencils** (as many as you can bring)
  - Highlighters** for several classes
  - Hand-held **pencil sharpener** with shaving holder (not motorized)
  - Red Pens
  - Black or blue **erasable pens** (the kind that doesn't click)
    - ❖ Please do not send any gel pens or non-erasable pens!!!
  - Two or more **large gluesticks**
  - Safety scissors** (no longer than 2" in length)
- 1 **Composition Book for Science**
- Mead 5-Star 200 pg. spiral notebook w/pockets** for Social Studies
- (3) **1½" binders** for Language Arts, Math and Science
- 2 sets of 8 tab dividers** for Language arts and Math
- loose leaf paper**
- 1 **package 3x5 index cards**
- Dry erase marker**
- 10 oz clear plastic cups for Science**
- Flashdrive** (recommended)
- Paperback book** to be carried with students to all classes
